SOLVING SUPPLY CHAIN CHALLENGES

Loyal Dircks Insider readers will recall how we have expressed our gratitude to our team for the way they have been able to pivot to best support our customers and our community over the course of an unprecedented few years. The disruptions faced by the supply chain industry in recent times are no different — we are proud of our Business Services and Logistics teams for using their expertise and resources to help alleviate some of those challenges for our customers.

To accommodate the increased need for quick access to high levels of inventory, we have increased our Valley footprint to over 650,000 square feet of warehouse space. Included in this space is an exclusive 100,000 square foot facility dedicated to our customer, Fairlife. We are currently warehousing and distributing up to 10,000 pallets of nutritional products at a time for Fairlife, helping to get their product to consumers quickly and efficiently.

As many industries face issues due to shortages, the Dircks team has been

assisting our customers with inventory control. Dircks has teamed up with a local car producer to help manage their inventory due to car part shortages in the auto industry. We have also provided inventory management and distribution of new technology services for a major credit card company, as well as assisted a solar company by distributing over 400 truckloads of solar modules to a solar field in Southern Arizona.
